- Violence Against Children in Madrassa project meeting held on 3<sup>rd</sup> August 2018. The Center for Sustainable Conflict Resolution committee held a meeting at CSCR offices to deliberate on how to take the project to the next level, find out what needs to be done, expected challenges and implementation strategies.
- The National Counter Terrorism Centre (NCTC) convened a workshop for counsellors and psychologists on disengagement and rehabilitation of violent extremists. The workshop took place at Eanshipai Lodge Naivasha from Monday 6th to Thursday 9th August 2018. CSCR mobilized BRAVE members from Isiolo, Garissa, Nyeri, and Nairobi to participate.
- Arigatou International-Nairobi in partnership with the government of the United Arab Emirates (UAE) Ministry of Interior organized 3<sup>rd</sup> pre-conference interfaith dialogue workshop for faith communities in the Sub-Saharan Africa region on Child Dignity Online. The 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> Pre conference workshops were in Egypt and Ghana respectively. The pre-conference took place at Sarova Panafric Hotel, Nairobi on 7th August 2018. Countries represented in workshop were Tanzania, Uganda, Siere Leone, Nigeria, Cameroun, and the host Kenya. Representatives from Muslim, Christian, Hindu, Sikh and traditional religious communities attended. The main conference will take place in November 2018 in the United Arab Emirate (UAE).
